


List of cities and towns in Georgia (country)

This is a list of the cities and towns (Georgian: ქალაქი, *k'alaχ'i*) in Georgia, according to the 2014 census data of the Department of Statistics of Georgia.^[1] The list does not include the smaller urban-type settlements categorized in Georgia as daba (დაბა). The list also does not include cities and towns in the disputed territories of Abkhazia and South Ossetia.
